Submission Guidelines

All papers are subject to a double-blind peer-review process. Authors retain the copyright to the articles they publish in the journal. *TxE*d does not publish material that has been previously published and does not accept papers that have been simultaneously submitted elsewhere for publication.

We encourage the submission of a wide range of manuscripts, including but not limited to:

- Special Education Interventions
- Special Education Policies
- Diversity and Equity in Special Education
- Special Education in Higher Ed
- K-12 Special Education Best Practices
- Other original manuscripts related to the issue topic

Submitted manuscripts must be in American Psychological Association, Seventh Edition (APA 7th Ed.) format. Submit manuscripts as a single Microsoft Word file with a brief abstract (no more than 75 words) and a list of up to five keywords.
